A special message from Jamie Hansen regarding Vineyard Pruning assignment.

There is a special theme to this years vineyard service and it comes from fact that this is the final year of our Thompson Seedless Vineyard. It comes from The Book of Mormon, Jacob chapter 5:71,76 & 77.

71 – “And the Lord of the Vineyard said unto them: For behold **Go to and labor in the vineyard, with your might.** For behold this **is the last time that I shall nourish my vineyard;** for the **end is nigh at hand,** and the season speedily cometh; and if ye labor with your might **with me** ye shall have joy in **the fruit which I shall lay up unto myself** against the time which will soon come.”

76 – “...and for **the last time** have I nourished my vineyard, and pruned it and dunged it; **wherefore I will lay up unto mine own self of the fruit**”

77 – “... **And then cometh the end; and my vineyard will I cause to be burned with fire.**”

"Pruning can take place anytime now, and needs to be completed by 28 January 2023. We are anticipating that all Wards will complete all of their Pruning & tying of their assigned Ward rows. If you wait til the last Saturday in January, yes it may be difficult to complete your assignment. We ask you to announce in your meetings this Sunday that all individuals & families, Quorums & groups that have a desire to come and prune to please come and do so.
