- \* Year-round gardening

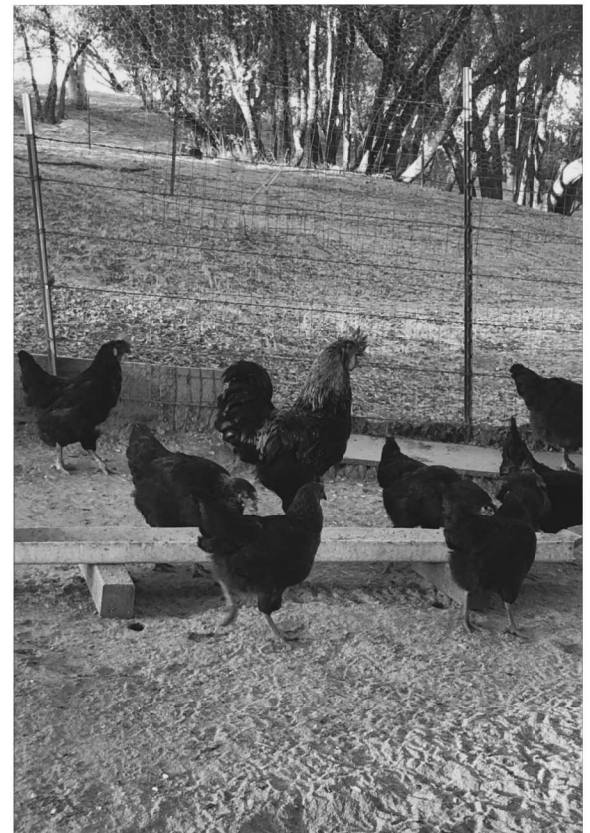
